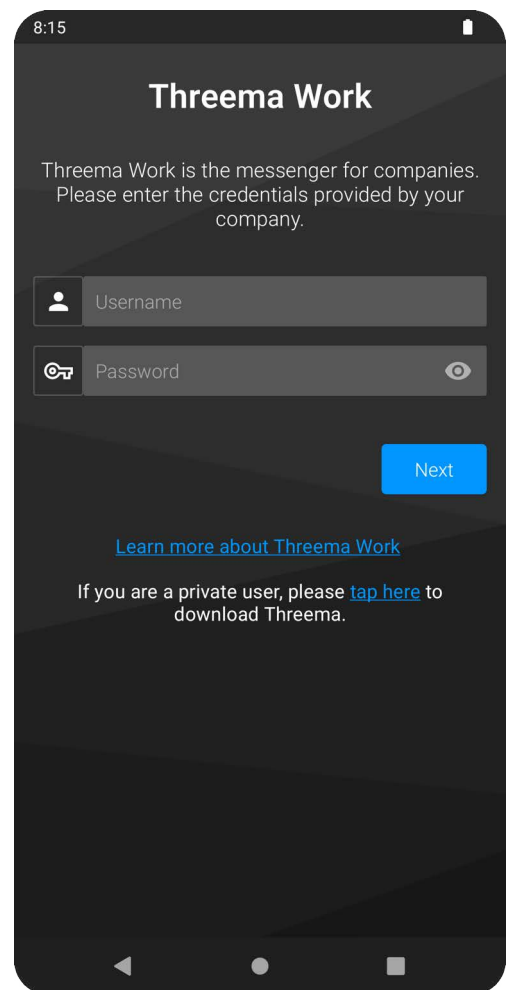

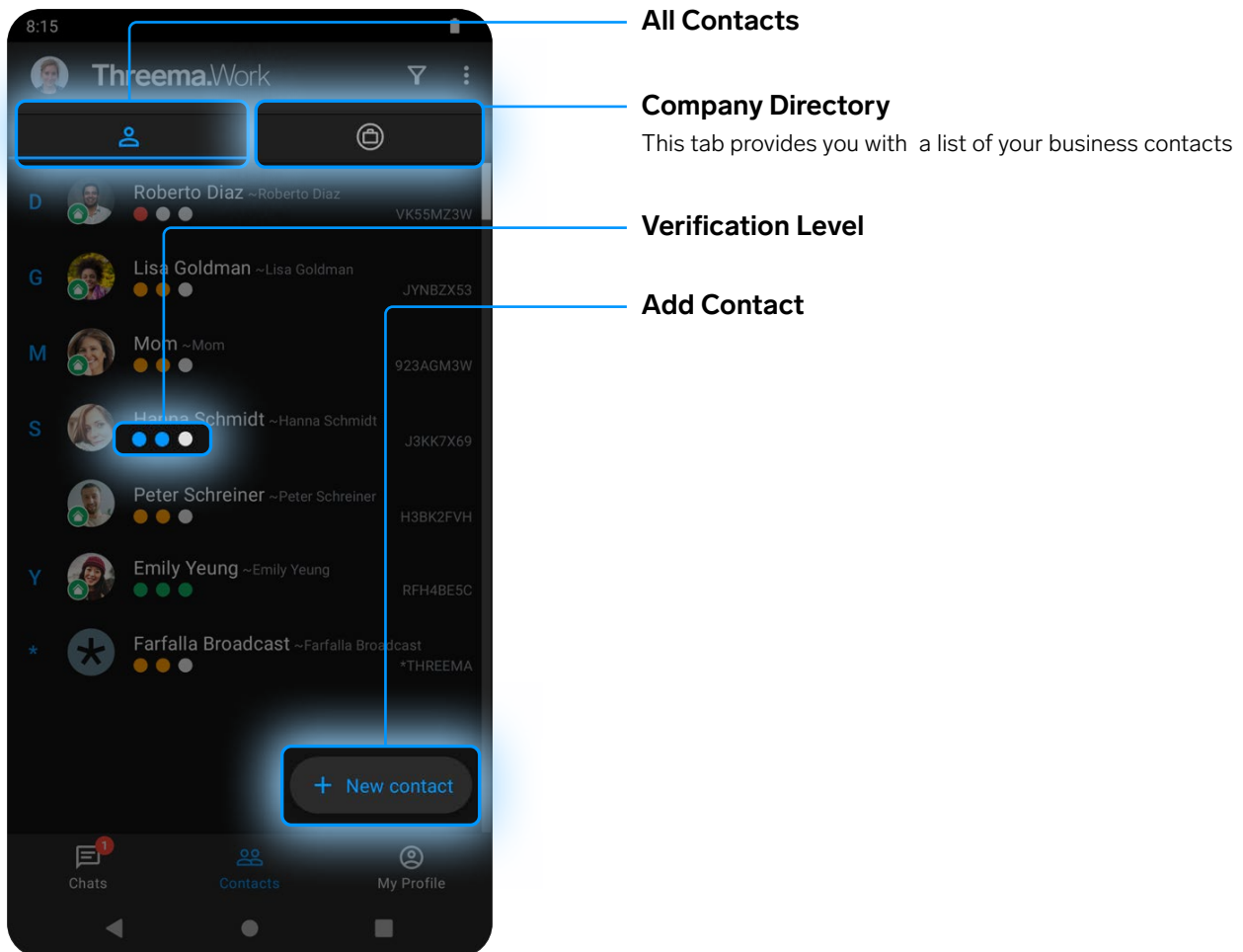
- Download Threema Work in the app store



- Open the link you received from your administrator
 - Alternatively, you can add your username and password manually after opening the app for the first time
- The setup wizard will now guide you through the process

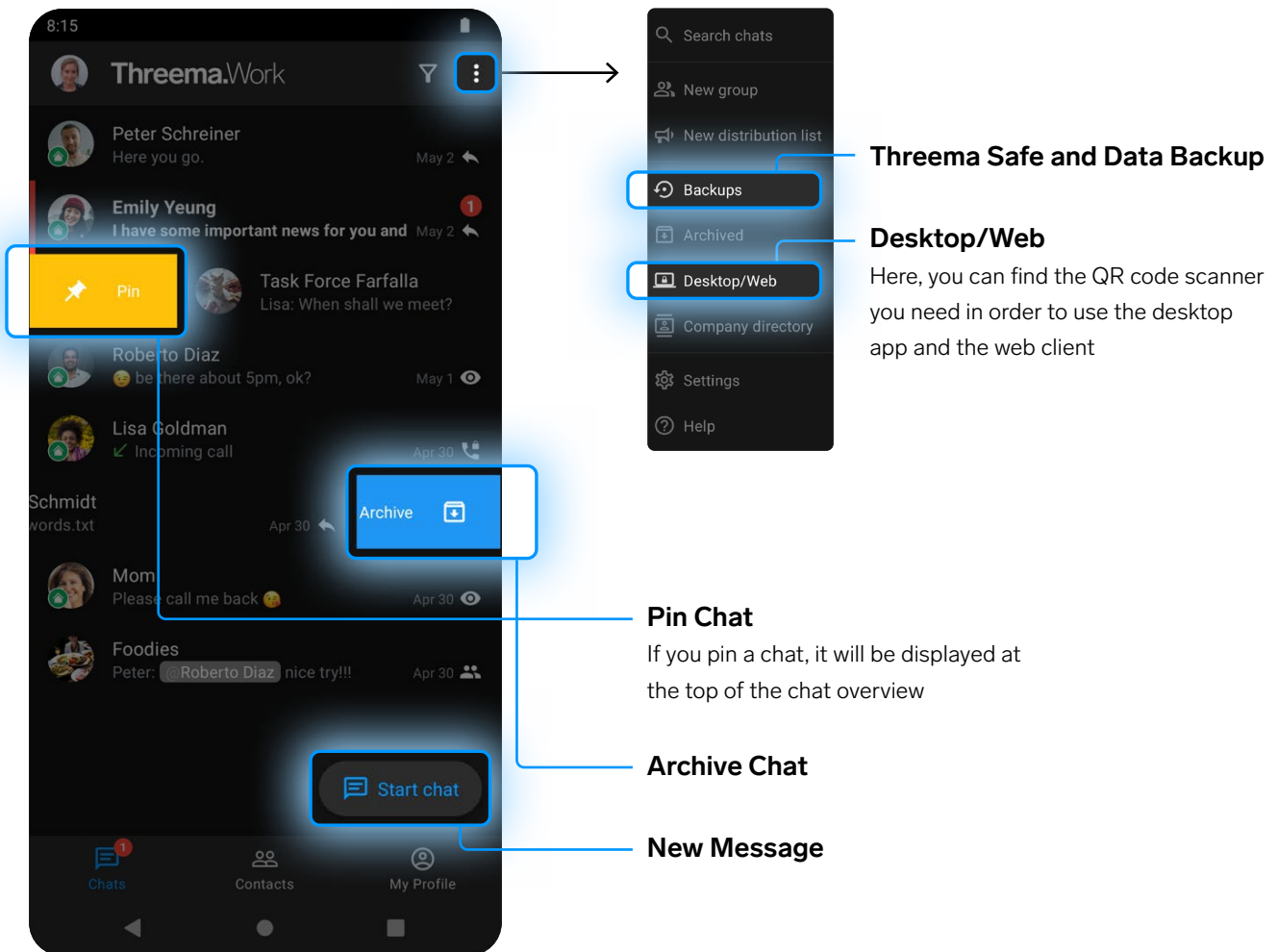


Tips and Tricks

- A group in which you are the only member can be used to store information and notes securely. Messages you send to that empty group chat will stay on your device and are not sent to the server.
- The three dots indicate the verification level of a contact. They don't affect the encryption strength but are a measure for the probability that the saved public key of a contact indeed belongs to that contact.

The verification level can be changed to the highest level by scanning the QR code of the contact (see "My Profile," p. 7).

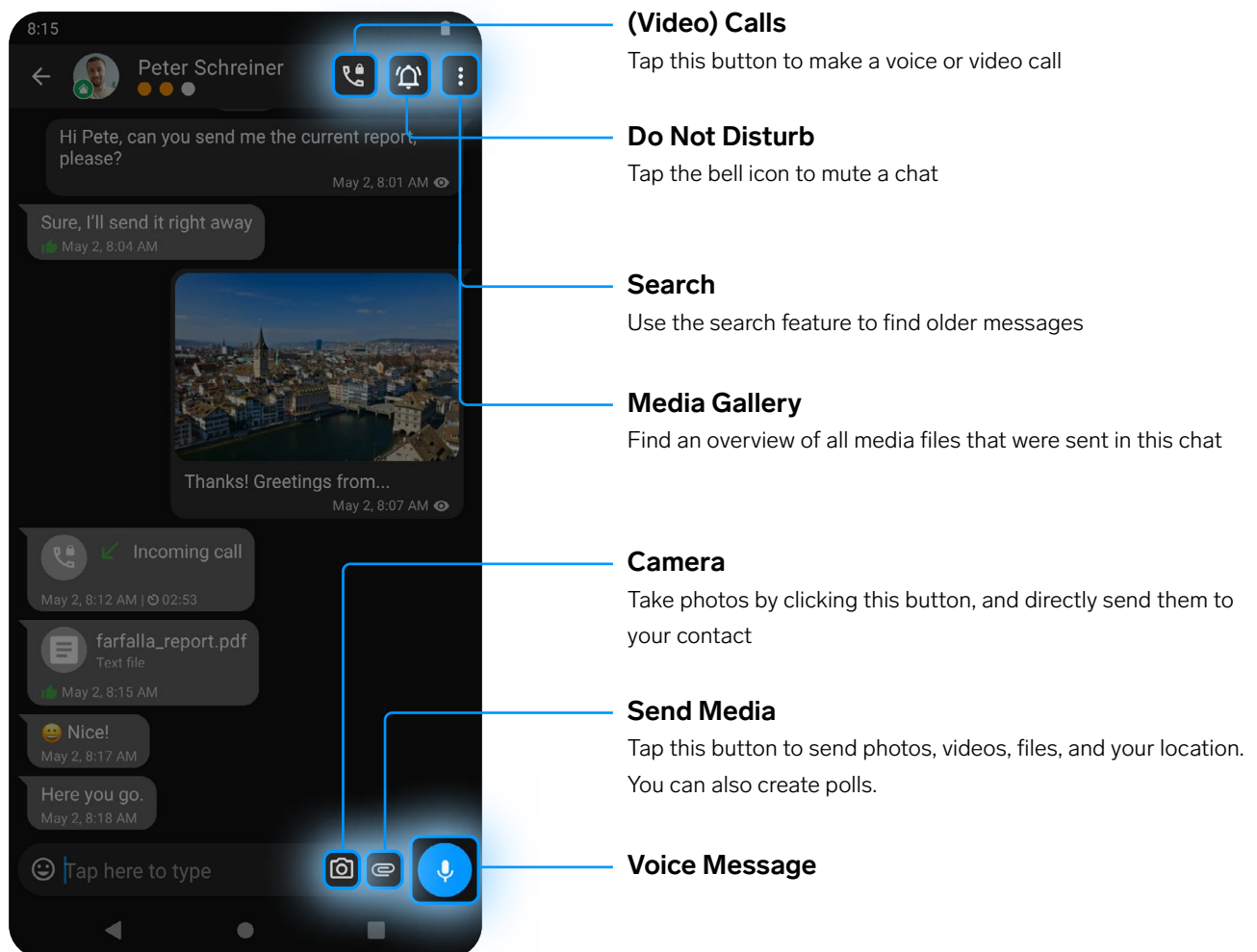

Tips and Tricks

- Use distribution lists to reach multiple contacts at the same time. The recipients won't see who else received the message.
- Use backups to restore your data when switching to a new phone. More details can be found on this page (https://threema.ch/docs/work/android_backup_manual_work_en.pdf).

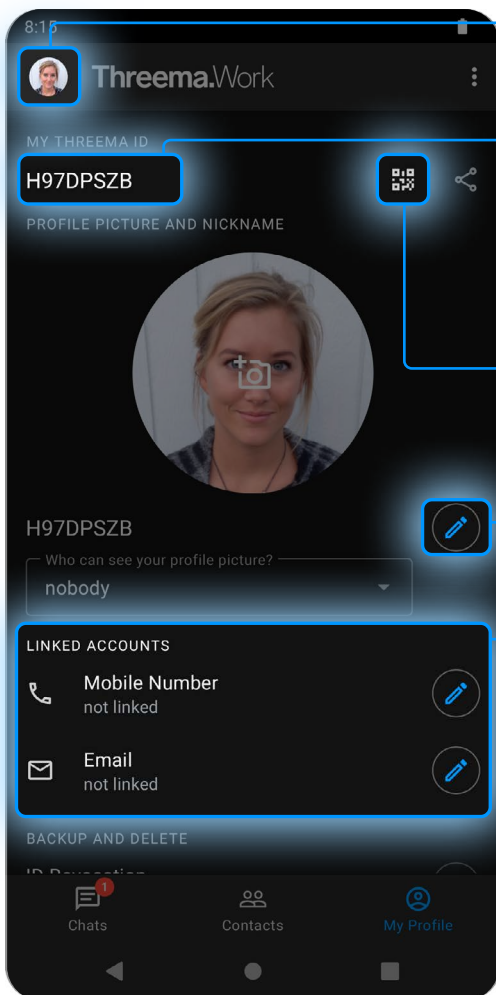

Scan QR Code

Use this scanner to add and verify contacts

Threema-ID

This is your Threema ID. Tap on the icon on the right to share it

QR-Code

This is your QR code. Let your friends scan it to add you to their contacts or verify your ID

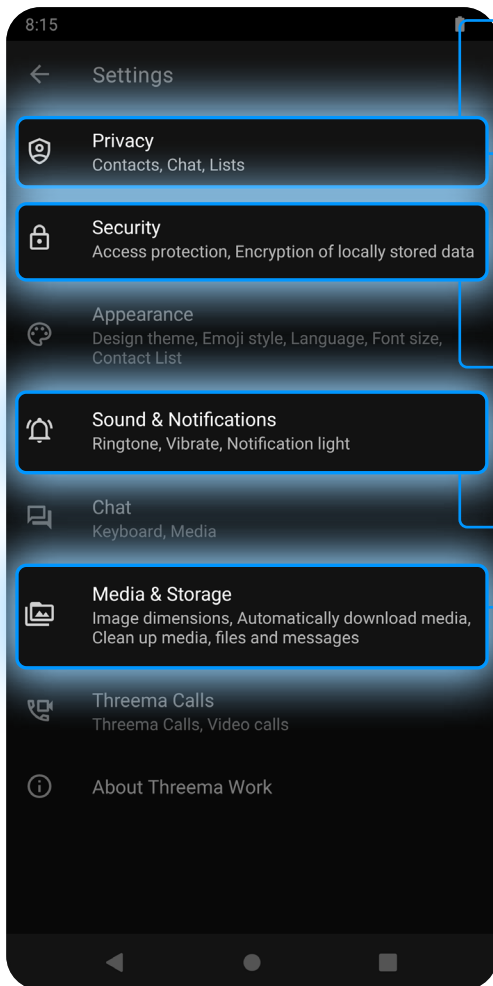
Edit Nickname / Profile Picture

Tap this icon to change your profile picture and your nickname

Linked Contact Information

Your linked accounts will be used to automatically add you to the contact list of people who have saved your number and/or your email address

Settings



Sync Contacts

If this option is activated, contacts from your address book who use Threema will be automatically added to your contact list

Block Unknown

When activated, you can't be contacted by people whose ID you haven't saved

Passcode Lock

Add a passcode lock if you require additional protection for the app

Off-Hours Policy

Automatically Save Media

Tips and Tricks

- The off-hours policy allows you to set the days and hours you work, so you won't be disturbed during your free time.
